- 2 p.m.** "Henry Shaw's Botanical Garden," lecture by Andrew Colligan, Garden Archivist. *Shoenberg Theater*
- 3 p.m.** "The past, present, and future of the Garden," lecture by Dr. Peter H. Raven, Garden President. *Shoenberg Theater*
