Requirements:

Must be a senior working on a B.A. in Photography/Arts. Coursework completed in photography, specializing in digital cameras. Proficiency in Photoshop for the Mac platform, scanning, and color correction. Must have your own digital camera, cell phone, and transportation.

Job description:

The Photography Intern at the Missouri Botanical Garden will essentially function as a staff photographer shooting events and grip-and-grins, as well as editorial images. Photo intern will also coordinate photo requests, and archive/process digital files. Recent interns have had their photos published in the Garden's Bulletin magazine, ads in a variety of newspapers and magazines, and on Garden posters, flyers, and other support pieces.
