


Hydrophyllum macrophyllum

Large-Leaf Waterleaf

Family: Hydrophyllaceae
[Gleason and Cronquist 1991],
Boraginaceae [Judd et al.
2007]

Notes: *Hydrophyllum
macrophyllum* is native in
Indiana.

Corolla 8–13 mm long, 5-lobed to near the middle or below, white (pinkish); calyx about half as long, 5-lobed to near the middle; stamens 5; ovary 1, style 1, shallowly 2-parted. Blooms May 1–July 6.

Inflorescence with fine
spreading hairs 1–2 mm long.

Fruit a capsule
0.6–1.5 cm.

Early leaves in a basal rosette, leaf 2–3 times as long
as wide, soft to the touch, with hairs 1–2 mm long.



Perennial herb to 0.7 m; leaves all pinnately
divided. Woods.
